When does Westport's firework show start? **The Booming Bay Fireworks Display begins at dusk at the Westport Marina!**

Are fireworks legal? **According to WA State and Westport municipal code, fireworks can be discharged legally during a specific period. Fireworks are ILLEGAL in and adjacent to WA State Parks and not allowed within the City of Westport, Half Moon Bay, or North of Twin Harbors State Park.**

Specifically prohibited: **Firecrackers, skyrockets, salutes, chasers, and bottle rockets.**

Discharge Period:

June 28: Noon to 11 p.m.

June 29 - July 3: 9 a.m. to 11 p.m.

July 4: 9 a.m. to midnight

July 5: 9 a.m. to 11 p.m.

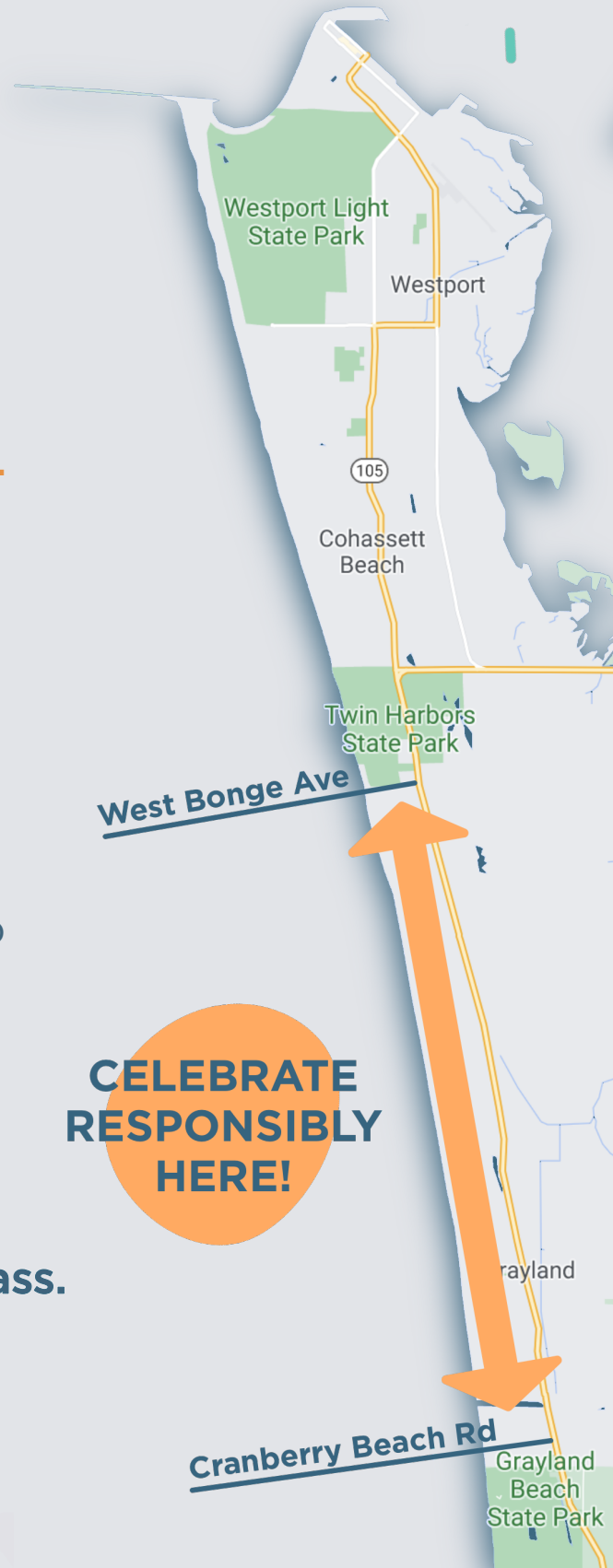
Discharge periods apply to the locations on the map only.

Where can I discharge approved fireworks?

Fireworks can be safely discharged on the beach from West Bonge Ave to Cranberry Beach Rd.

You must be 100ft+ away from the dunes and grass.

Leave no trace! Clean up after you're done having fun! Keep our beaches clean!
